Thomas se Dolland Pinotage 2020

Pinotage, a cross between Pinot Noir and Cinsaut, is a truly South African variety. Old bush vines, established in 1960. The vineyard was named after Thomas, who worked the soil with only horse and plough, his tenacity lives on.

The vineyard is Atlantic influenced and has a cool micro-climate. Coffee Stone with pot clay soils. Cold soaked for ten days at 8 °C and fermented up to a maximum of 25 °C. 14 months in 2nd and 3rd fill French oak barrels.

VINEYARD: Stellenbosch Kloof

Intense aromas of raspberries, mulberries and ripe plums. An elegant wine with a lengthy finish.
