Swaartekrag Chenin Blanc 2020

‘Swaartekrag’ means ‘Gravity’, it refers to the vineyard with its old bushvines in Swartland where the grapes come from. This is a certified Heritage vineyard, established in 1968.

The grapes were cold-soaked on the skins at 7 degree Celsius for two days. Natural fermentation then took place in 300 liter French and Hungarian oak barrels of which 20% was new oak. Matured on the lees for 8 months.

VINEYARD: Swartland

TASTING NOTES:

Wooded Chenin blanc with aromas of peach blossoms, white pear and citrus, following through on a rich, buttery, concentrated palate.

This Chenin Blanc can easily mature up to 10 years.
